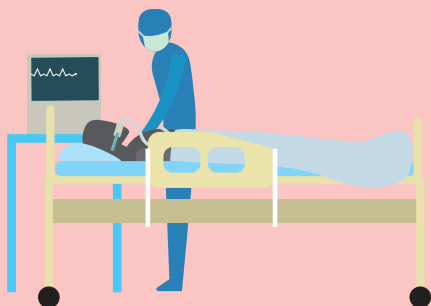


# Organ Donation Procedures



1



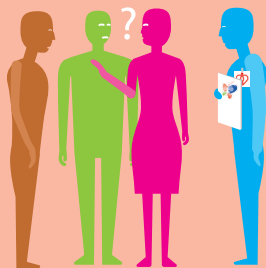
Patient is certified brain dead. Healthcare professionals would assess patient's suitability for deceased organ donation.

The Organ Donation Coordinator will affirm if the deceased has expressed a wish of organ donation while alive through methods such as checking against the Centralised Organ Donation Register.

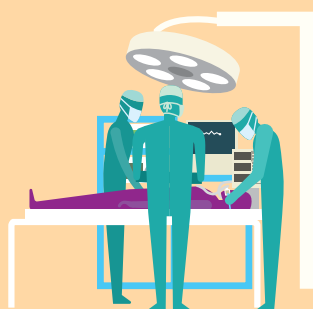
The Organ Donation Coordinator explains the details of organ donation to family members and seek their written consent to deceased organ donation.

4



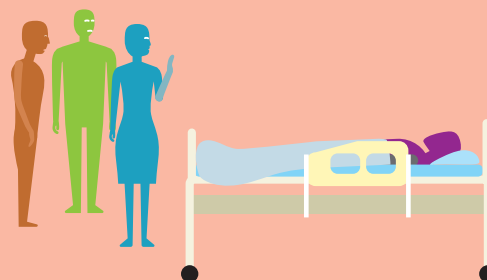
After obtaining the family's written consent, healthcare professionals would conduct relevant assessment of the donor and cross match between the waitlisted patients and the deceased donor.

The hospital would arrange harvesting of the deceased organs for transplantation as soon as possible.

6



Upon completion of organ harvesting, the deceased donor would be transferred back to the ward for last respect by the bereaved family.
